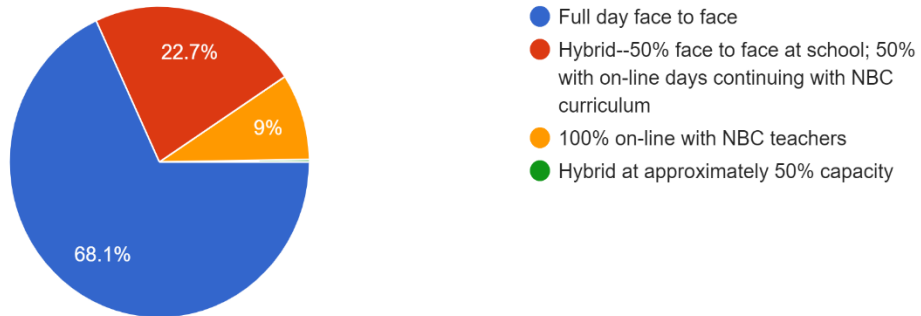


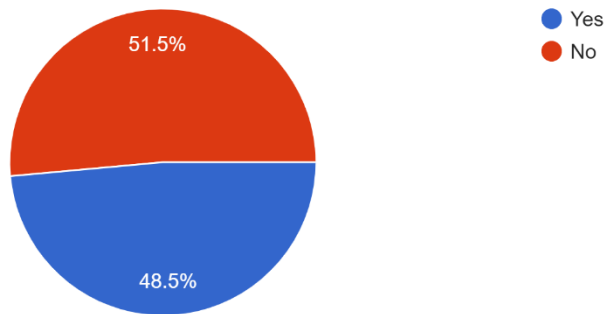
Which mode of educating your child(ren) do you prefer to begin the 20/21 school year?

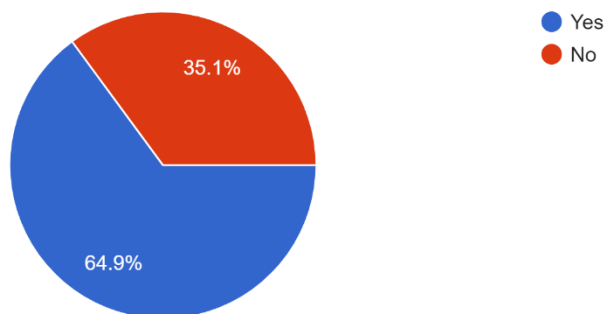
Are you in favor of your child(ren) returning to school every day (instead of a hybrid) if a face covering is required by health organizations to be worn all day?

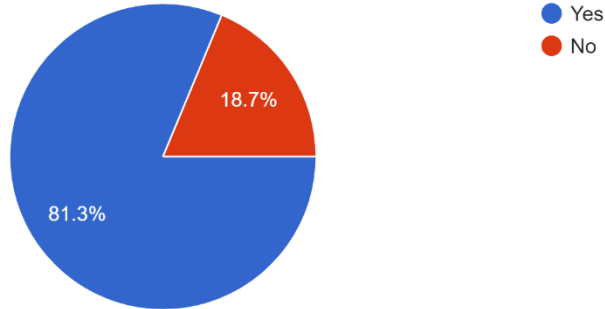
If the district is required to enforce the wearing of face coverings all day, will you still send your child(ren) to school?

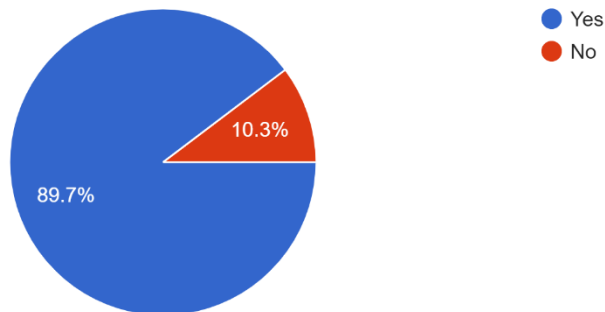
If a hybrid schedule is needed, please select the option that best suits your schedule. The days students are not at school, they will be working on-line continuing with NBC teacher curriculum.

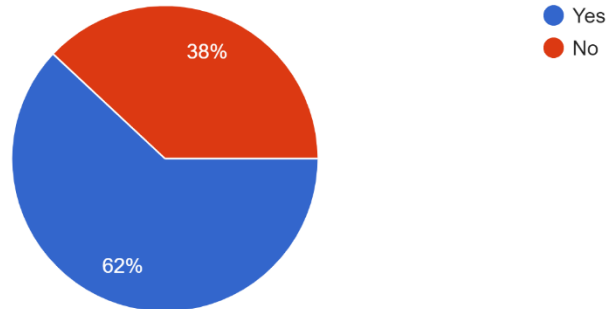
If the district begins the year with a hybrid model, will you send your child(ren) to school?

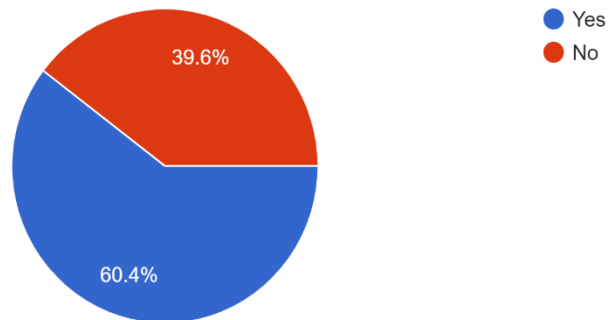
If all students are able to return to school, would you prefer the district provide NBC on-line learning one day a week to complete a deeper sanitation of the buildings in addition to daily sanitation?

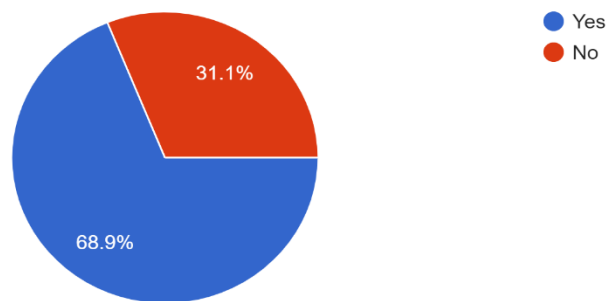
There are recommendations from health organizations to treat COVID-19 similar to other communicable diseases such as influenza, strep throat, etc. Will you still send your child(ren) to school?
