

## Food Service Information

We've made a few changes to keep students and staff safe. When it comes to preparing and serving school meals, safety has always been a top priority. In light of the Covid-19 pandemic, we've enhanced training for our staff and made a few changes to our procedures. Staff will wear face coverings, wash hands frequently, and will be excluded from work if ill. Together, we'll work to make it a great year and a safe year!

Menus are posted on the school's website for Group A and Group B days. We will be providing bulk meals for pick up on Wednesdays that will include 3 breakfast and 3 lunches. The meals will be provided through the National School Lunch Program regulations. Therefore, the meals must go to only enrolled NBC students and will be purchased based on their household income eligibility. Your family may qualify for free or reduced priced meals. Meals will be available on Wednesdays from 11-12 at the high school. Anyone can pick up the meals, as long as they have the student's id# that they are picking the meals up for. The student's accounts will be charged for the meals at the time of pick up. You may enter at the kitchen entrance and follow the posted signs.
