#### Writing Your Personal Reflection/Summary of Your Job Shadow Experience.

<u>Objective</u>: To summarize your job shadow experience by reflecting on what you observed and what you learned.

**Possible topics:** Possible topics to focus your essay on are suggested. You can select one topic or a combination of topics. You may also create a different topic based on something you learned or experienced.

## Possible essay topics are:

- Describe the different job duties you observed today.
- Compare skills you saw today and how they relate to school or your activities.
- Discuss the value of the job shadowing experience.
- Discuss and compare the parts for the job you found interesting and those that you did not like.
- Would you consider a career in this field? Why or why not?

### Additional Requirements:

- ✓ *Must be typed.*
- ✓ Minimum one-page essay, which includes three paragraphs an opening, body and closing
- ✓ Use 12 font and one inch margins
- ✓ Attach essay to job shadow report

**Overall Project Grading:** Each part of the project, job shadow report and essay, will have equal weighting – both are worth 50% of the total grade.

### Rubric Categories:

- 1. Content: Writing includes details of the job shadow experience; written responses on form are complete.
- 2. Reflection: Writing demonstrates exploring and analyzing of the job shadow experience
- 3. Organizations: Clear, well organized ideas
- 4. Mechanics: Grammar, Usage, Spelling
