Dear Parents and Guardians:

In compliance with the Federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, as reauthorized in 2015 by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Northern Bedford County School District, is attempting to identify all children within the District that may be experiencing homelessness.

The term homeless children and youth, is defined as individuals who lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence. This includes individuals who are in the following situations.

- Staying with friends or family because you lost housing.
- Living in a shelter, including transitional programs.
- Staying in motels because you cannot get your own home.
- Living on the streets, in a car, van, tent or other nonpermanent structure.

Children who are experiencing homelessness may qualify for assistance with free school breakfast and lunch, school supplies/materials, tutoring and transportation so that they can remain in their school of origin throughout the duration of their homeless episode.

If you believe your child(ren) may qualify for this service, please contact your building Principal or the homeless liaison, Mrs. Stacy Pressel.

If your living situation changes during the school year, and you and your children become homeless, please be sure to contact the school. We will work with you so that your child's education is disrupted as little as possible.
